



Sunset Beach Community Association Meeting Minutes

November 3rd, 2022

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 with the Pledge of Allegiance and introductions.

Minutes:

- The minutes from the October 6th meeting are being reviewed.

Treasure's Report:

- Chris Harrison reported a beginning balance of \$18345.70, deposits/donations of \$10,984.00, expenses of \$543.08, and an ending balance of \$28,786.62.
- There were deposits/donations including \$7,000.00 Chili Cook-off (Woman's Club), \$3,034.00 Rock Concert (Las Damas), \$450.00 Mayor applications and \$500 from Facility rentals.

- The expenses included \$65.00 Vinatech Solutions (monthly website support), \$121.23 in utilities, \$206.85 to Kevin Paulson reimbursement (Table replacement & cleaning supplies), \$2,439.85 to the County of Orange (property taxes), \$150.00 to Jules Coover (Event clean-up 9/10 and 9/17) re
- This left an ending balance of \$28,786.62
- Upcoming expenses-Property Taxes \$2,478.10 (1st Installment

Correspondence:

Board Comments:

- Chris Harrison and Brandi Lennertz commented on the success of the Pirate Halloween party at the community center and thanked Tony Nobles and his team for all of their hard work. Tony Nobles showed a slide show of the party and it was obvious everyone had a great time!!

Public Comments:

- Gail informed the community about the passing of longtime resident Sue porter. She asked the board to advocate having a bench and/or tree placed in her honor on 4th St.

Guest Speakers:

- Graham Hoad from the Sanitary District updated the community on past projects done in Sunset Beach/ Huntington Harbor. He also mentioned a possible large upcoming project replacing old sewage pipes (last replaced 1936). This project is still in the design phase and could potentially help eliminate sewage spills in the future. This project would require construction to the Greenbelt and the removal of some trees.

- Kim Weddon informed the community that this year will be the 60th anniversary of the Cruise Of Lights in the Huntington Harbor. The theme this year is Swinging to the sounds. 50-minute boat tours will be available benefiting the Philharmonic society. For tickets or questions visit www.cruiseoflights.org

HBPD Update:

- H.B.P.D. Lt. Archer addressed the communities' concerns about the new street sweeping. He noted that not all community members were opposed to it. There was a significant decrease in homeless sleeping in cars and the parking spots were much cleaner. He did note that having South Pacific and Parallel streets on the same Wednesday was problematic. He suggested a 3-month trial period to work out any issues and revisiting the issue after that time.

Board Member Elections:

- Kevin Paulson informed the board that we must hold elections for council members. He proposed that votes be taken at the post office this election cycle and revisited on how we vote for next election cycle. Tony Nobles brought the motion and Kevin Paulson seconded it. The board voted unanimously to approve.

Community Center Maintenance:

- Kevin Paulson asked for someone to bring a motion to replace the Community Center electrical. Tony Nobles brought the motion, Brandi Lennertz 2nd. The board voted unanimously to approve.
- Kevin Paulson asked for someone to bring a motion to replace security lights. Tony Nobles brought the motion, Alison Carman 2nd the motion. The board voted unanimously to approve.
