



**Notes from the Meeting with  
SUNSET BEACH AREA COUNCIL COMMITTEE  
Held on August 29, 2011 at 3:30 PM**

The Sunset Beach Area Council Committee (SBACC) consists of three members and is the liaison between the HB City Council and the Sunset Beach Community Association (SBCA) & Sunset Beach residents. The three member SBACC committee consists of Mayor Joe Carchio, Council Member Devin Dwyer and Council Member Keith Bohr.

All three SBACC members were present at the meeting as were SBCA president Mike Van Voorhis, Secretary Tim McCormack & board member Gretchen Hoad. In addition, approximately 20 residents of Sunset Beach attended the meeting as did the HB City Manager, asst City Manager, Fire Chief, Police Captain and other members of the HB government.

***Sunset Beach was welcomed into Huntington Beach by Mayor Joe Carchio and the HB Council members. They stated that all necessary signatures have been obtained and the annexation is complete.***

Other information included the following:

**No Change**

- Sunset Beach addresses will not change. The zip code (90742) and the post office remain in place.
- No change in lifeguards
- Fire first responders remain the same. It is the station at Warner & PCH
- Sunset Beach streets are scheduled to be paved, and the county will proceed with that schedule.
- Future undergrounding of utilities on PCH & Sunset Island will continue as planned under county auspices

**Immediate Changes – Effective August 29, 2011**

- Law Enforcement shifted from the County Sheriffs to HB Police effective 8/29
  - HB is also responsible for writing accident reports instead of CHIPS
- 911 phone calls are routed through the HB switchboard rather than the county
- HB will take over Fire Inspections of Sunset Beach businesses from the Seal Beach Fire Department

**Changes Effective 10/1/2011**

- The maintenance of the Greenbelt & Bathrooms will move to HB
- HB will take over responsibility for the parking lot at that time. They intend to continue locking and unlocking the parking lot & restrooms as before.

**Future Changes**

- Planning and building services including inspections will remain with the County until the new LCP is approved by the state Coastal Commission. Estimate is that this process will take about 1 year.

**General Information**

- SBACC will meet regularly with the SBCA and Sunset Beach residents. The thought was that initially, meetings might occur once per month, and then shift to quarterly. These meetings will be in addition to regularly scheduled SBCA meetings.
- The SBACC would like to have a ribbon cutting ceremony to welcome Sunset Beach to Huntington Beach.
- HB police have scheduled talks to exchange information with the Sheriffs regarding massage parlors and marijuana clinics in Sunset Beach
- Parking permit process in Sunset Beach is different from HB's process. The police captain said they are going to meet with the county to become familiar with the process.
- A draft City Directory & Information Guide was distributed. It is attached.
