We also need to mention our regular attendees: Huntington Beach Council Woman Natalie Mosher, who is a great friend of Sunset Beach, and Huntington Beach Police Lieutenant Roman Altenbach who addresses all of our police related issues.

In 2020 I questioned if we were taking advantage of all the benefits of being a 501 (c)(3) charity.

I discovered that we hadn't been taking advantage of possible property tax reductions. I filed the proper paperwork with the state and the county in early 2020 and we were turned down. But with the help of our treasurer, Chris Harrison, and our accountant, Chris Montana, CPA, they led the charge and resubmitted the paperwork. With their hard work and diligence, they arranged a site survey by the county

and in September we were awarded a discount on our property taxes. This reduction lessens our annual overhead by a third. Our community owes thanks to these two for their hard work for the last 2 years.

With COVID restrictions in our rearview mirror we were able to hold all our annual events in addition to a couple new ones. In January Tincan Beach Combers, a local charity that focuses on clean beaches, clean food and local music, held a CPR class at the community center. They also, with the Huntington Beach Fire/Lifeguards put on a presentation called S.A.L.T., Surfers Awareness in Lifesaving Techniques in April. Great information for water goers.

Over Mothers Days Weekend Las Damas held the Sunset Beach Art Festival and as always, it did not disappoint. Thousands of people attended and this event went off without a hitch.

Starting off the summer events in July, the SCBA held our annual pancake breakfast where we had static displays for the police and fire department and of course, delicious pancakes with all the orange juice provided by Sammy Perricone. Followed by Barbara D'Angelo's Electric Rock Concert in August with a portion of the proceeds going to the SCBA. Ending the summer events was the Woman's Club 24th annual Chili-cook-off, which also shares a portion of their proceeds with the SBCA. This was their best year ever, according to Woman's Club President Dawn McCormack.

I wish everyone a happy holiday season and I am looking forward to 2024. Please share your email with us so you can stay in touch with all events in Sunset Beach.


